The Frankenmuth Arts Council is hosting their third iron pour which has officially been named as the Frankenmuth Fire Arts Festival. Join us at the Frankenmuth Farmers Market on Friday, September 24 and Saturday, September 25 where we will give aspiring artists the opportunity to create their own piece of fire related art. This family-friendly event will be filled with at least six different art experiences leading to the pour on Saturday evening, which will be a fiery experience for all to enjoy!

- Firenation Glass Studio and Gallery from Holland, Ohio will be bringing their portable hotshop to help the participant create a fall pumpkin via glass blown solid work.
- Two Guys and a Kiln from the local area will be leading workshops teaching the participant to glaze their own piece of pottery and fire using the ancient art of raku.
- We will be hosting an art competition for the amateur as well as the professional artist with the theme **Capturing the Fire in Your Art**.
- Art vendors will be present to sell their artwork.
- Demonstrations of blacksmithing and chain saw carving will also be present.
- New this year we are presenting an aluminum pour.
- Alien Iron Art Castings will once again present the pour on Saturday evening.
