This year's event

This year marks the third annual **Frankenmuth Fire Arts Festival**. We began in 2018 with an iron pour led by the local group, **Alien Iron Art Castings**. In advance, registrants designed and carved sand tiles which were then poured with molten iron. In 2019, we added workshops of blown glass solid work by hiring **Firenation Glass Studio and Gallery** from the Toledo area to give hands-on experiences. In 2021, we are adding workshops to teach the art of raku, led by **Two Guys and a Kiln**. We are also offering an amateur and professional art competition entitled, "Capturing the Fire in your Art." Previously, art vendors joined us, but this year we are opening that opportunity to many more participants.

We have limited space available to this show. Please submit your applications early.

The goal of this art fair at our Festival is to promote local artists with handmade items to sell. We are very open-minded to various types of items and artwork at this show, but we are especially excited for those who use the element of fire in the process of their work.

Acceptance in the show will be decided after application has been received and pictures of work have been submitted and reviewed by our jury. At that time, payment will be requested.

Several demonstrations will be held at various times during the Festival. We are also encouraging artists to demonstrate their work at their booths.

Exhibitor Rules and Regulations

1. Vendors will be invoiced upon acceptance via email with payment encouraged to be made through Pay Pal. If you prefer, you will also be allowed to send a personal check.
2. Absolutely NO flea market or garage sale type items, direct sales items, or resale items allowed. In order to provide a diverse lineup of exhibitors, show management reserves the right to limit similar product offerings and services, reject items we find in poor taste, or remove/refuse any person who does not conform to these regulations.
3. Vendors must submit at least three photos of your products. This may be done through e-mail, if desired. Photos sent through the mail will be returned to you at the event.
4. Vendors are required to staff their booth during ALL hours for the entire event, and must refrain from early breakdown of booths, removal of inventory, or loading of vehicles until the show has been officially closed.
5. Exhibitors will be informed with the details concerning times, guidelines, etc. upon acceptance to the show.
